



Proof of Emancipated Minor or Legal Guardianship 2018-2019

Your status for financial aid as an Independent student is based on your answer to the following questions on the FAFSA:

- *As determined by a court in your state of legal residence, are you or were you an emancipated minor?*
- *Does someone other than your parent or stepparent have legal guardianship of you, as determined by a court in your state of legal residence?*

The U.S. Department of Education requires us to verify Your status as an Emancipated Minor or in Legal Guardianship. You will need to submit the following:

A current copy of the court’s decision that you are an emancipated minor or are in legal guardianship. The court must be located in your state of legal residence.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Return this worksheet and the requested documentation to our office via one of the methods above.
2. If you are unable to provide this documentation, you will need to sign in to your FAFSA at www.fafsa.gov and answer “No” to the questions above. You will be required to provide your parent’s information on the FAFSA and one parent will need to sign the FAFSA before we can process your aid.
