

# 2023-2024 TEACH Grant

The Federal Teacher Education Assistance for College and Higher Education (TEACH) Grant is awarded through S&T Student Financial Assistance to students who are completing, or intend to complete, teaching coursework and who agree to serve for a minimum of four years as full-time, highly qualified, high-need field teachers in schools that serve low-income students.

Students awarded the TEACH Grant are required to complete four years of qualified teaching service within eight years of completing their course of study for which the TEACH Grant was received. Failure to meet this or any other requirement of the TEACH Grant will result in the grant converting into a Federal Unsubsidized Stafford Loan, with interest accrued and capitalized from the date of original grant disbursement.

#### To apply TEACH Grant, S&T students must:

- Complete a 2023-2024 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at <u>fafsa.gov</u> (S&T school code: 002517).
- Meet a qualifying academic achievement requirement (maintaining a cumulative GPA of at least 3.25). Current teachers, former teachers, and retirees are not required to meet this requirement.
- Be a degree seeking undergraduate student seeking their first bachelors or a degree seeking graduate student. (Students seeking a post-baccalaureate certification or a second undergraduate degree are not eligible.)
- Be enrolled in at least three (3) credit hours.
- Enroll in coursework necessary to complete a teacher certification in a high-need field.
- Complete this application each academic year.
- Complete TEACH Grant Initial Entrance Counseling and Subsequent Counseling yearly.
- Sign a TEACH Grant Agreement to Serve or Repay (Agreement) from the US Department of Education.

#### Award Amounts:

Due to automatic federal budget cuts, known as the 'Sequestration," for any TEACH Grant first disbursed on or after October 1, 2021, the maximum award of \$4,000 is reduced by 5.7 percent (\$228), resulting in a maximum award of:

#### <u>To fulfill the TEACH Grant Agreement to Service requirements, a recipient must:</u>

- Serve as a full-time highly qualified teacher in a low-income school in a high-need field as listed in the Nationwide List and for the state in which you will be teaching most classes for at least four years within eight calendar years of leaving the program for which you received the TEACH Grant. High-Need fields are these specific fields: bilingual education, English language acquisition, foreign language, mathematics, reading specialist, science, and special education. For others, and to access the Nationwide List of highneed field areas please go to tsa.ed.gov/#/home/.
- Write to the Secretary of Education (within 120- days of completing or otherwise leaving the program of study for which the TEACH Grant was received) confirming that you are employed as a full-time teacher in accordance with the terms of the TEACH Grant, or you are not yet employed as a full-time teacher but intend to meet the terms of the TEACH Grant service agreement.
- Respond promptly to any requests for information or documentation of the service in the form of a certification by a chief administrative officer of the school.
- Submit upon completion of each year of teaching service, documentation of the service in the form of a certification by a chief administrative officer of the school.
- Comply with all other terms, conditions, and requirements that the Secretary of Education determines to be necessary.

Failing to meet any of the terms above will result in the TEACH Grant funds you received converting into a Federal Direct Unsubsidized Stafford Loan, with interest accrued and capitalized from the date of original disbursement(s). Once this grant is converted to a loan, it cannot be converted back to a grant.
